How it works:

- **Receive your results**
- **Learn how to make any corrections**

Testing includes:

Iron	Manganese	Sulfate	Hardness	Coliform bacteria
Sodium	Copper	Nitrate	Arsenic	<i>E. coli</i> bacteria
Fluoride	pH	Total Dissolved Solids	Lead
